Located on 14.7 acres at Lafayette Regional Airport (LFT), this aerospace/aviation manufacturing and final assembly facility also houses office and meeting spaces. The \$25 million facility, owned by the Lafayette Airport Commission, offers many fabrication and delivery options.

New terminal opens at Lafayette Regional Airport

At 129,000 sq. ft., the new terminal is more than twice as large as the existing terminal. The terminal has five boarding gates with room to add two more. In addition to the terminal, the project includes a new remote transmitter/receiver (RTR) facility, an expanded parking lot, a consolidated rental car facility, concessions on both sides of the security gates, and an advanced baggage handling system.
